New Church Planned
St. Ansgar's Votes To Buy Land Option
The congregation of St. Ansgar Evangelical Lutheran Church voted last night to purchase the option on land in the Rosemont area as a site for a new church.
By an almost unanimous vote at a special meeting the congregation voted to purchase the option on more than 16,000 square feet of land at 507 Woodford St.
The Rev. Vincent P. Ligouri said the option was for two years and a third year, if mutually agreed upon. The price was not disclosed.
He said plans for the building itself are still in the formative stage, but indicated actual construction should get under way in 1959.
