THE BAG

This enlarged postcard shows the interior of Haines Pharmacy in Skowhegan, Maine, circa 1910. Custom-designed and built by Geo. H. Bangs Co. of Boston, the mahogany centerpiece behind our bar and the apothecary display cases were relocated here in 1973. Note the "Walgreen" sign, a hallmark of excellence in those days, as well as the "Haines" sign in the bottom of the Bag. All the pieces are original and in excellent condition despite being stored in a barn, and buried under tons of hay.

The three newel posts at the entrance and near the stairs came from a Congregational Church in Portland and

were found in a salvage yard in 1972. The stained glass over the east wall windows were from reconstruction at the Methodist Church in Farmington, Maine.

All the stained glass and light fixtures are original and salvaged. However, the balustrade divider in the main dining room was designed and constructed by our crew when the Bag opened under its present management in 1973.
